P-member status of our National Committee

Since mid-2016 and during each plenary meeting, IEC central office reports on the participation of the national committees with “P” membership status.

National Committees voting on technical documents but not participating to plenary meetings are therefore invited to confirm their “P” membership.

Indeed, voting on technical documents alone does not meet the multiple requirements for P-membership as described in [1.7.4 of the ISO/IEC Directives Part 1](#).

Therefore, in order to keep its P-membership status, our National Committee will need to appoint at least one expert *and/or* contribute to TC/SC meetings either physically (also web meeting is allowed) or by correspondence, in addition to voting on any committee documents. Experts who contribute substantially to MT/WG/PTs by correspondence are considered to be participating experts.

Set-up of a new ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 41 - Internet of Things and related technologies. The scope of this subcommittee is the standardisation in the area of Internet of Things and related technologies.

1. Serve as the focus and proponent for JTC 1's standardisation programme on the Internet of Things and related technologies, including Sensor Networks and Wearables technologies.
2. Provide guidance to JTC 1, IEC, ISO and other entities developing Internet of Things related applications.

- Develop a sustainable process for incorporating communication technologies into relevant IEC committees.

SEG 9 - Communication Technologies and Architectures of Electrotechnical Systems. The scope of this SEG 9 is to

- Evaluate technology trends and market evolution trends.
- Review the inventory of existing standards and standardization projects within the IEC and external to the IEC, and advise the SMB where duplication of activity and potential dilution of technical resources is occurring.
- Evaluate and prioritize gaps in standardization.
- Recommend to the SMB the structure most appropriate for standardization of Smart Home/Office Building Systems.
