Annexes ZA/ZZ to CEN/CENELEC harmonized Standards - September 8, 2017

Since the introduction of the EC 'Vademecum on Standardisation' in the frame of Regulation (EU) 1025/2012, the 'informative Annex ZA/ZZ' has become a hot topic. Building on the experience gained in different sectors this Webinar will give a state of play on the different ways to successfully identify the link between the Essential Requirements in legislation and the clauses of a standard: accepted templates, right granularity, link to risk assessment, etc.

SESEC Stakeholders Consultation Meeting - September 13, 2017

This conference is the occasion for stakeholders to share views on how European standardization is promoted in China thanks to SESEC project. During the meeting they can express their current needs and future expectations, besides discussing on how to facilitate the China standardization alignment with European stakeholders' interests.

Why? After 10 years operation of SESEC project, China had obviously gone through a big economic and political change. Phase III is now over and this is the time to think about what more SESEC project can bring to the various European stakeholders. In order to do so, the participants together with the project partners will gather views on what are the successes and the areas for improvement, ideas for fine-tuning, future focus and inputs on how to make the project even more market relevant.

What? This workshop will enable stakeholders to express their perception on how the project should help them through the standardization sector perspective. The participants will have also the opportunity to revise their strategic requests on China standardization activities and collect proposals or suggestions for the next phase of the project, namely SESEC IV.

For whom? This meeting is open to all the stakeholders interested in the SESEC Project, those who have already business and will have business in China. More in general, this session is open to all the stakeholders interested in understanding and influencing how standardization can further support trade relations between EU and China.

New regulations on medical devices and related standards: ensuring a successful transition - September 21, 2017

The **Medical Device Regulation** (MDR) and the **In Vitro Diagnostic Medical Device Regulation** (IVDMDR) were adopted on 5 April 2017, replacing the existing Directives. The new Regulations will come into force after the expiration of the transition period, meaning 3 years for MDR and 5 years for IVDMDR.

Over 300 **harmonized standards** have been developed **to support the existing Directives**. Under the Regulations, existing harmonized standards will have to be revised and in addition new harmonized standards may need to be developed in order to correspond to the revised essential requirements.

Ensuring a smooth transition will be key to ensure that the stakeholders may benefit from the presumption of conformity granted by cited harmonized standards representing state of the art, and which at the same time advance patient advantages and safety.
