### **New TC created at IEC at the request of Belgium: IEC TC 125**

The proposal to create a new TC at IEC level for 'Personal e-Transporters' was launched at the end of 2018 and approved by SMB in the spring of 2019. This IEC TC 125 is a Belgian proposal and the first European proposal in more than 10 years. It will address the standardization for electrically powered means of transport (without human propulsion) for use on the road or in the public domain whereby the speed control and/or the steering is electrical and/or electronic. Cars, motorcycles, mopeds and bicycles are excluded from this TC since they are already handled by other TC's. But devices which are included, are monowheels, steps, stints, ...

Belgium holds the Secretariat of the IEC TC and the first international meeting of this IEC TC will be in Brussels on the 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> of September 2019.
